Waterbrook Bible Fellowship is celebrating our 5 Year Anniversary NEXT Sunday, August 30th.

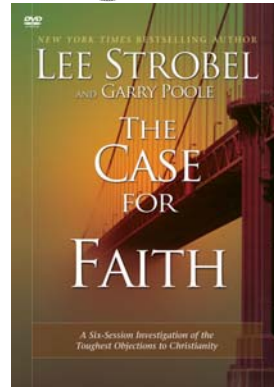

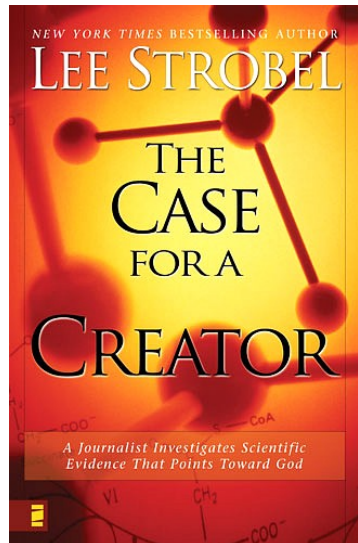

The Case for a Creator

Some in the scientific community have spent years trying to use science to prove God doesn't exist. Wes Bolton uses Lee Strobel's *Case for a Creator* video curriculum to reveal how science proves God definitely DOES exist. This class is also an excellent resource for parents who want to be able to have intelligent discussions with teachers who don't necessarily share a biblical worldview, and should enable you to talk openly with your children about the evidence that points to God in creation.
